BOSF carries out these roles not alone but in collaboration with local governments, the Natural Resources Conservation Center, NGOs, and communities to maintain forest ecosystems. In addition, BOSF conducts research and monitoring to understand orangutan behavior, health, and social interactions. Modern technology is also utilized to increase orangutan populations and improve their habitat. Through various education and conservation programs, BOSF not only protects orangutans but also promotes sustainable conservation practices.
